

## Common Kestrel

The Common Kestrel is a widespread bird that can be found in Europe, Asia and Africa. It is small compared to other birds of prey, but larger than most songbirds. Its plumage is mostly chestnut brown with blackish spots on the upperside. There's a bright yellow ring around the eye, the bill is yellow and grey and the feet are yellow. Its tail is gray with a black band.
